### SCALE OF ASSESSMENTS FOR APPORTIONMENT OF THE REGULAR BUDGET EXPENSES

#### Scale of assessments for the fiscal period 2002-2003

Note by the Secretariat

Provides draft scales of assessments for the fiscal period 2002-2003 for consideration by Member States.

#### I. SCALE OF ASSESSMENTS

1. The Programme and Budget Committee is required under Article 10.4 of the Constitution to prepare the draft scale of assessments for regular budget expenditures, for submission to the Board. In accordance with Article 15.1 of the Constitution of UNIDO, "regular budget expenditures shall be borne by the Members, as apportioned in accordance with a scale of assessment established by the Conference by a two-thirds majority of the Members present and voting, upon the recommendation of the Board adopted by a two-thirds majority of the Members present and voting, on the basis of a draft prepared by the Programme and Budget Committee."

2. Article 15.2 states that "the scale of assessments shall be based to the extent possible on the scale most recently employed by the United Nations. No Member shall be assessed more than twenty-five per cent of the regular budget of the Organization."

3. On 23 December 2000, the General Assembly adopted resolution 55/5 B-F containing a new United Nations scale of assessments for the three-year period 2001-2003, which establishes:

- (a) A minimum assessment rate of 0.001 per cent;
- (b) A maximum assessment rate for the least developed countries of 0.01 per cent;

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(c) A maximum assessment rate of 22 per cent.

4. In paragraph C.3 of the resolution, the General Assembly stressed that the reduction of the maximum assessment rate of 22 per cent "shall apply to the apportionment of the expenses of the United Nations and should have no automatic implication for the apportionment of the expenses of the specialized agencies or the International Atomic Energy Agency."

5. The maximum rate for the current biennium is 25 per cent, in accordance with the UNIDO Constitution (para. 2 above). However, the Permanent Representative of Japan to UNIDO made a formal request in a letter dated 8 March 2001 that "the UNIDO Secretariat should prepare a draft budget on the basis of a maximum assessment rate of 22%" in view of the United Nations General Assembly resolution referred to in paragraphs 3 and 4 above.

6. Taking into account the above facts, the Secretariat has prepared two draft scales of assessments for the fiscal period 2002-2003 based on the current biennium's maximum rate of 25 per cent and the new United Nations maximum rate of 22 per cent, adjusted to the membership of UNIDO, for consideration by Member States.

7. Adjustments to the scale to include any State that may become a Member between now and the closure of the ninth session of the General Conference in accordance with Articles 3, 24 and 25 of the Constitution will be communicated to the Conference.

8. The application of the assessment rates adopted by the General Assembly for the years 2002 and 2003 to the Member States of UNIDO results in total assessments of 74.547 per cent for 2002 and 74.58400 per cent for 2003, owing to differences in membership between the United Nations and UNIDO (see columns 1 and 2 of annex). To produce a scale of assessment that covers 100 per cent of regular budget expenditures of UNIDO, it is necessary to apply a mathematical coefficient to the United Nations rates for UNIDO Member States. The coefficient is not applied to the rates of United Nations Member States paying the minimum assessment of 0.001 per cent, and it ensures that the rate of least developed countries does not exceed 0.01 per cent as well as the maximum rate of any UNIDO Member State not exceeding 25 per cent or 22 per cent, respectively. The coefficient calculations are shown in the table below.

9. Columns 3-4 (25 per cent) and 5-6 (22 per cent) of the annex to the present note show the adjusted rates for the scale of assessments for the fiscal period 2002-2003

for States that were Members of UNIDO as of 28 February 2001, by applying the coefficients for 2002 and for 2003 as explained in paragraph 8 above. Column 7 shows assessment rates for the fiscal period 2000-2001, which have been included for comparison only. The coefficients under the maximum rates of 25 per cent and 22 per cent are:

#### **New Member States**

10. In accordance with financial regulation 5.6, new Members shall be assessed for the year in which they become Members at rates to be determined by the Conference.

#### **II. CURRENCY OF ASSESSMENTS**

11. In accordance with General Conference decision GC.8/Dec.16, beginning with the fiscal period 2002-2003, a single currency system of assessment based on the euro for contributions to the regular budget is being introduced. In the same decision, the Conference also amended the concomitant Financial Regulations of UNIDO relating to the preparation of budgets, appropriation and assessment, collection of contributions and advances, and currency of accounts.

#### **III. ACTION REQUIRED OF THE COMMITTEE**

12. The Committee may wish to propose to the Industrial Development Board the adoption of the following draft decision:

"The Industrial Development Board:

"(a) Takes note of document IDB.24/5-PBC.17/5;

"(b) Recommends to the General Conference the establishment of a scale of assessments for the fiscal period 2002-2003 as contained in columns ... and ... of the annex to document IDB.24/5-PBC.17/5, on the understanding that new Members shall be assessed for the year in which they become Members on the basis of the United Nations scale of assessments;

"(c) Urges Member States to pay their assessed contributions for the 2002-2003 biennium in accordance with financial regulation 5.5 (b)."
