TUESDAY, 23 June 2009

1st PLENARY MEETING

The thirty-sixth session of the Industrial Development Board was opened by H.E. Mr. Horacio Bazoberry Otero, (Plurinational State of Bolivia), President of the thirty-fourth and thirty-fifth sessions.
