SUMMARY OF MEETINGS

1st plenary meeting

Item 1: Opening of the thirteenth session

The Conference was opened by the temporary President H.E. Mr. Omar Zniber (Morocco), who made a statement.

The Conference observed a minute of silence dedicated to prayer or meditation.

Item 2: Election of officers

(a) Election of the President

H.E. Mr. Ali Asghar Soltanieh, Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran to UNIDO, was elected by acclamation to the office of the President of the thirteenth session of the General Conference.
