Opening of the session

The fortieth session of the Board will be opened by the President of the Board, H.E. Mr. Cho Hyun (Republic of Korea).

Item 1. Election of officers


In accordance with rule 23.1 of the rules of procedure, each year, at the commencement of its first regular session, the Board shall elect from among the representatives of its members a President, three Vice-Presidents and a Rapporteur. Rule 23.3 stipulates that the offices of the President, the three Vice-Presidents and the Rapporteur shall be subject to equitable geographical rotation within a five-year cycle described in appendix A to the rules of procedure. Accordingly, for the fortieth session, the President should be elected from members of the Board among the States included in List D of Annex I to the Constitution. The three Vice-Presidents should be elected from members of the Board among the African States in List A and the States included in Lists B and C, respectively. The Rapporteur should be elected from among the representatives of members of the Board among the Asian and Pacific States included in List A.

Item 2. Adoption of the agenda

A provisional agenda for the fortieth session, based on the provisional agenda adopted in decision IDB.39/Dec.13 and updated to reflect mandates of the General Conference, is submitted to the Board for adoption in document IDB.40/1.

Item 3. Annual report of the Director-General for 2011 on the activities of the Organization

In accordance with Article 11.6 of the Constitution, the Director-General is to prepare an annual report on the activities of the Organization. Due to the reduction of the number of sessions of the Board in non-General Conference years (decision IDB.39/Dec.7 (f)), the annual report was, for the first time, presented through the twenty-eighth session of the Programme and Budget Committee to the current session of the Board. Annotations in relation to the annual report and its content were contained in the annotated provisional agenda of the Committee session (PBC.28/1/Add.1).

In line with Article 9.4 (d) of the Constitution and decision IDB.1/Dec.29, Member States delivered statements, which included information on their activities related to the work of the Organization, at the twenty-eighth session of the Committee.

In accordance with General Conference resolution GC.14/Res.5, the Director-General reported on the development of entrepreneurial and industry related programmes and initiatives targeting young people in the *Annual Report of UNIDO 2011* (IDB.40/2, chapter 3).

A report on the progress made in implementing General Conference resolution GC.14/Res.2 on knowledge networking and knowledge sharing for achieving development goals was also contained in the *Annual Report of UNIDO 2011* (IDB.40/2, chapter 6). That report will be updated in a note by the Secretariat to reflect latest developments.
