Opening of the session

The forty-first session of the Board will be opened by the President of the fortieth session, H. E. Mr. Balázs Csuday (Hungary).

Item 1. Election of officers

In accordance with rule 23.1 of the rules of procedure, each year, at the commencement of its regular session, the Board shall elect from among the representatives of its members a President, three Vice-Presidents and a Rapporteur. Rule 23.3 stipulates that the offices of the President, the three Vice-Presidents and the Rapporteur shall be subject to equitable geographical rotation within a five-year cycle described in appendix A to the rules of procedure. Accordingly, for the forty-first session, the President should be elected from members of the Board among the States included in List C of Annex I to the Constitution. The three Vice-Presidents should be elected from members of the Board among the African States in List A, the Asian and Pacific States in List A, and the States included in List B, respectively. The Rapporteur should be elected from among the representatives of members of the Board among the States included in List D.

Item 2. Adoption of the agenda

A provisional agenda for the forty-first session, based on the provisional agenda adopted in decision IDB.40/Dec.14, is submitted to the Board for adoption in document IDB.41/1.

Item 3. Annual report of the Director General for 2012

In accordance with Article 11.6 of the Constitution, the Director General is to prepare an annual report on the activities of the Organization. In its resolution GC.4/Res.2, the General Conference requested the Director General to fully incorporate in future annual reports the programme performance report according to Board decision IDB.7/Dec.11. At the request of the Board in decision IDB.23/Dec.12, annual reports include information on operational activities for developments arising from relevant United Nations General Assembly resolutions, including the quadrennial comprehensive policy review (United Nations General Assembly resolution 67/226 of 21 December 2012). In compliance with resolution GC.10/Res.5, Member States are kept informed in the annual report of UNIDO's role in achieving the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs). In line with resolution GC.13/Res.3, the *Annual Report of UNIDO 2012* covers information on the implementation of the medium-term programme framework, particularly with reference to its activities in support of achieving the MDGs in its three thematic priorities, and to specific accomplishments in improving the overall approach of the United Nations system's development cooperation in support of national development priorities and strategies, and national capacity-building.

Article 9.4 (d) of the Constitution stipulates that the Board shall request members to furnish information on their activities related to the work of the Organization. In decision IDB.1/Dec.29, Member States were requested to inform the Board on their activities related to the work of the Organization when reviewing the annual report. Member States may wish to include this information in the oral statements delivered by their representatives under this item. Such statements would be reflected in the summary records of the Board.

Information on the progress made in implementing decision IDB.40/Dec.12 on industrial innovation and productive capacity is also contained in the *Annual Report of UNIDO 2012*.

Item 6. Medium-term programme framework

At its fourteenth session the General Conference took note of the midterm review of the medium-term programme framework (MTPF) 2010-2013 and decided that the MTPF 2010-2013 remained in force until its scheduled expiry in 2013 (decision GC.14/Dec.18). With the same decision, the General Conference requested the Director General to submit on a quadrennial basis, from 2013 onwards, to the Board in the second year of a biennium, through the Programme and Budget Committee, a draft medium-term programme framework for the four years that follow the current biennium, taking into account the recommendations of the latest comprehensive policy review of operational activities for development. As the consultations of the informal working group on the future, including programmes and resources, of UNIDO were still ongoing, the Director General presented a proposal to the Programme and Budget Committee at its twenty-ninth session recommending that the adjusted MTPF 2010-2013 remain in force until the expiry of the forthcoming budget biennium, 2014-2015.

Item 7. Informal working group on the future, including programmes and resources, of UNIDO

In accordance with Board decision IDB.39/Dec.7 (h), an informal working group of interested Member States to provide guidance on the future, including programmes and resources, of UNIDO was established under the co-chairmanship of H. E. Ms. A. T. Dengo Benavides (Costa Rica) and Mr. A. Groff (Switzerland) in November 2011.

In line with the terms of reference of the informal working group (document GC.14/14 and Corr.1), an interim report on the activities of the working group shall be submitted to the UNIDO policymaking organs biannually until the fifteenth session of the General Conference. A third interim report of the Co-Chairs was submitted through the twenty-ninth session of the Programme and Budget Committee to the current session of the Board. That report will be updated through a fourth report.

Item 10. Personnel matters

In decision GC.14/Dec.20 the Conference elected the two members and two alternate members of the UNIDO Staff Pension Committee for the biennium 2012-2013.
